<p>Mission Statement</p>	<p>The Staatstheater on Gärtnerplatz unites operas, operettas, musicals and dance all under one roof. It is one of four stages around the world that presents all genres of musical theater on an equal footing, and is considered one of Europe's leading multi-purpose cultural facilities. Well in excess of 200 performances, plus numerous special events, adorn the diverse program every year.</p>	
<p>Selection of venues</p>	<p>Gärtnerplatztheater stage, studio stage, orchestra rehearsal room, large foyer and further performance spaces with mobile productions for younger audiences.</p>	
<p>Program</p>	<p>The Gärtnerplatztheater presents operas, operettas, musicals and dance in more than 200 performances per season.</p> <p>The program in spring 2018 boasts an extra special first performance: In collaboration with Anne X. Weber, renowned theater creator and composer Franz Wittenbrink has written a musical about the stalwart Munich cult character, PUMUCKL. The famous goblin will whirl across the stage beginning in April.</p> <p>The operetta THE CHOCOLATE SOLDIER celebrates a première in June. Director Peter Konwitschny was hired for the new production, and with it makes his house début.</p> <p>A suspense-filled love triangle forms the dramatic centerpiece of Federico Fellini's film classic „La Strada“ from 1954. Choreographer Marco Goecke takes Fellini's film and the score by Nino Rota as the basis for an intoxicating ballet performance about the conflict between basic human emotions, such as love, hate and jealousy. LA STRADA celebrates its première on 12 July 2018.</p> <p>Musical State Director Josef E. Köpplinger will announce the 2018/19 season program on 7 April during the annual press conference.</p>

Price per person: € 10 / Group price: € 160 (max. 25 people)</p> <p>Theater gastronomy: Enjoy the gastronomy service in the foyer and in the Salon Pitzelberger, which is also open for you after the performance from Wednesday to Saturday.</p>
