

Mission Statement	Gärtnerplatztheater stands for entertainment theatre on the highest level, for diversity, humanity, and tolerance. It is an internationally renowned opera house and one of only four theatres world-wide whose repertoire unites all aspects of musical theatre. Musical state director Josef E. Köpplinger has been managing the theatre since 2012. With over 300 events every year and an occupancy rate of over 90%, the Gärtner-platztheater welcomes over 150.000 visitors every season, who value the wide range of operas, operetta, musical, dance and concert.	
Selection of venues	Gärtnerplatztheater stage, studio stage, orchestra rehearsal room, large foyer and further performance spaces with mobile productions for younger audiences.	
Program	 The Gärtnerplatztheater presents operas, operettas, musicals and dance in more than 300 performances per season. Get excited for the following premiers until July 2019: Giacomo Puccini's masterpiece LA BOHÈME (March 28th), the swing-musical ON THE TOWN by Leonard Bernstein (April 26th) and Maurice Ravel's L'HEURE ESPAGNOLE (April 28th) as well THE YOUNG LORD in a production by Brigitte Fassbaender (May 23rd) and the world premiere of the "expedition-ballet" ATLANTIS (June 7th). Of course repertoire highlights such as the family musical PUMUCKL, the evergreen MY FAIR LADY, Mozart's THE MAGIC FLUTE, the newest production hit THREE MEN IN THE SNOW inspired by a novel by Erich Kästner and last but not least PRISCILLA – QUEEN OF THE DESERT, will continue to be part of the program.
